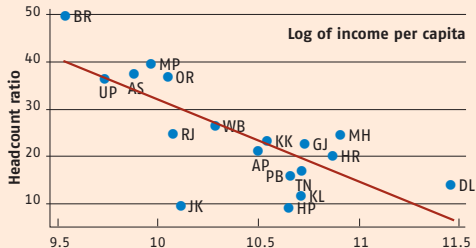
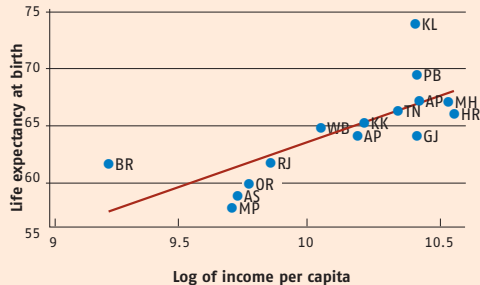


Income and poverty, 2009 Figure 1



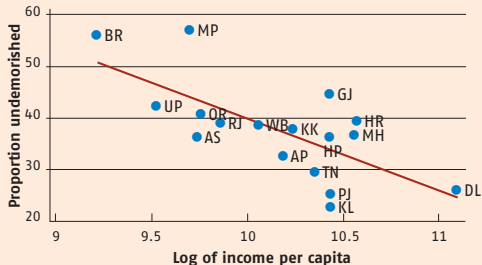

Income and health, 2004 Figure 2



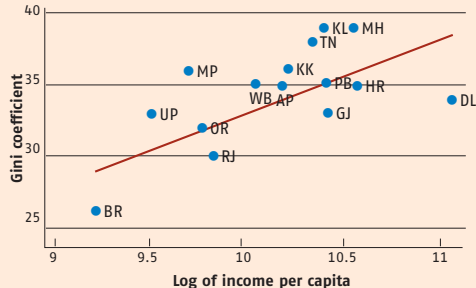
